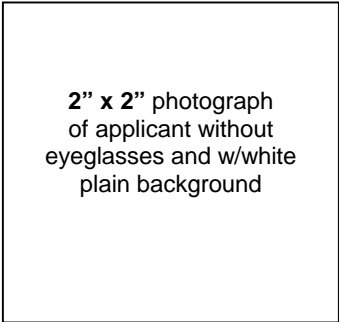

Requirements for 9(a) Temporary Visitors:

- A passport or duly recognized travel document valid for a period of at least six (6) months beyond the last day of stay in the Philippines.
- Visa application **FA Form No. 2A** which may be filed either in person, through an accredited travel agency, or by mail. An application sent in by mail must be accompanied by a self addressed stamped envelope with sufficient postage to cover the cost of returning the visaed passport to the sender by **certified priority mail with return receipt**. The Consulate General, however, will not be held responsible for any loss or delay in the mail.
- One (1) passport size photograph of the applicant.
- Photocopy of a roundtrip/onward flight plane ticket or travel itinerary from a travel agency/airline.
- Application should be notarized if the applicant cannot file personally.

Additional Requirements, whichever may be applicable:

- **For Business Purposes** – submit a business letter or company letter stating purpose of travel, duration of stay and financial means of support.
- **For U.S. Immigrants** – submit a photocopy of U.S. Resident Alien Card or U.S. Reentry Permit.
- **For U.S. Employment Visa Holders** – submit a photocopy of U.S. Employment Permit or Employment Visa.
- **For minor children under age 15 travelling with 1 parent** – attach a notarized letter of consent of parent who is not accompanying the child.
- **For minor children under age 15 travelling unaccompanied by a parent or not joining a parent in the Philippines** - visa exempt minors (those who by virtue of their nationalities may be admitted without a visa to the Philippines for a stay of 21 days or less, e.g., Americans, Canadians, etc.) need not obtain a visa but will be required to present before the immigration officer upon arrival in Manila all documents necessary for Waiver of Exclusion Ground (WEG). All other foreign minors who are not visa-exempt (e.g., Indians, Iranians, etc.) and who would normally require entry visas should obtain a visa and submit the WEG requirements to immigration authorities within 3 days upon arrival in Manila. WEG requirements are: 1) Application for WEG; 2) Affidavit of Consent & Support executed before any Notary Public; 3) Copy of Birth Certificate of the child; 4) Copy of the Data Page of the child's passport. Guidelines on WEG requirements and filing procedures are available at the Philippine Consulate General's Front Desk and Visa Section.

FEES:

- US \$ 30.00 for single entry visa valid for three (3) months
- US \$ 60.00 for multiple entry visa valid for six (6) months
- US \$ 90.00 for multiple entry visa valid for twelve (12) months
- (For each entry, a visa is usually good for an initial stay of 59 days)

PAYMENTS MUST BE MADE IN CASH, POSTAL MONEY ORDER, BANK DRAFT, OR CASHIER'S CHECK ONLY. PERSONAL CHECKS ARE NOT ACCEPTED.
